He was Laurie opposite Sutton Foster's Jo in *Little Women* and in *Urinetown* on Broadway; he was in the national tour of *The Full Monty*, the NYC Opera and Kennedy Center's production of *A Little Night Music*, and was Papa Who in the recent production of *How the Grinch Stole Christmas* at the Pantages Theatre. He's a graduate of the University of Michigan Musical Theatre program; he's currently on the Musical Theatre faculty of AMDA in Los Angeles; and he's at PSA for one day only this summer!
